Produce News

Apples: New crop of Washington-grown Gala and Honeycrisp Apples are starting this week. Washington State Red Delicious, Envy, Fuji, Granny Smith and Pink Lady Apples continue but quality is declining as these are all controlled atmosphere, old crop Apples. Goldbud Farms Gala Apples are in stock this week. These 1st of the season, California-grown Apples are sweet and crisp. Brisa Ranch's Organic Mutsu Apples are now in stock. The Mutsu is a cross of a Japanese Indo and Golden Delicious Apples with sweet/tart taste and crisp texture. Organic Gravenstein Apples continue.

Blackberries - Overall quality is just fair for the Watsonville grown berries; soft, over ripe and red cells are the main issues at this point. Rain in Mexico continues to affect the growing

Blueberries - The Pacific Northwest supply remains steady but quality has been hit and miss due to rain in some growing regions. Peru season is still expected to start the end of August or first week of Sept.

Raspberries - Watsonville supply remains steady, and quality is hit and miss due to recent heat; berries are showing up soft and bruised. Rain in Mexico also continues to affect the growing areas; supply and quality will be the main issue.

Strawberries – Santa Maria is expecting steady supply with additional fields expected to be harvested this week; quality is better and the fruit sizing is much bigger. Watsonville production projection has been adjusted lower the expected; quality has been hit and miss.

Figs: Comanche Creeks Organic mixed variety Fig supplies are gapping until midweek. Capay Organics Candy Striped Figs supplies are steady this week. Black Mission supply is in peak production coming from Fresno, and prices are starting to come off. Season will run through October.

Lettuce: Both Living Butter Lettuce and Watercress supply has slowed down again due to low yield, pack count is low due to this reason. Upland Cress and Mache supply are very tight due to poor germination. Red Veined Sorrel supply is steady from Pennsylvania. Red Watercress is very limited coming from Florida.

Melons: Durst Farms Organic Blackjack Watermelons supplies are steady. Full Belly Farms Organic Charentais, Goddess, Piel De Sapo, Sharlyn, Orchid and Yellow Doll Watermelon Signific Charling, Goldies, Flet De Sapo, Sharyi, Olchi and Fellow Dolf Waterflicon supplies are steady. Galia and Snow Leopard are gapping this week. California-grown Watermelons continue from the Central Valley with good color and sugar levels. California-grown Cantaloupes and Honeydew Melons are now from the west side of the San Joaquin Valley, good quality & sugar levels.

Pomegranates: Granada variety pomegranates are available from the Fresno area. Pack size is 32/36 count.
