# Fall Seasonal Items

## APPLES

Northern California's fall season brings an abundance of apples, with varieties like Fuji, Gala, and Granny Smith reaching their peak. Their crisp texture and balanced sweetness make them perfect for both sweet and savory dishes, from classic apple pies to fresh salads and roasted pork accompaniments.

## BROCCOLI

Thriving in the cooler fall temperatures, broccoli is at its peak from October through early winter. Its robust flavor and versatility make it a staple for steaming, roasting, or incorporating into soups and casseroles.

## BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Best from late fall through winter, Brussels sprouts develop a sweeter flavor after the first frost. Roast them to bring out their natural caramelization, or shave them raw into salads for a crunchy addition.

## GRAPES

Table grapes are plentiful through October. Their natural sweetness and firm texture make them ideal for fresh applications, such as salads, and cheese boards, or for creating house-made jams and sauces.

## KALE

This leafy green thrives in the cooler weather of fall and winter, providing a hearty, nutrient-dense ingredient. Use kale in salads, sautés, or as a base for braising greens, taking advantage of its robust flavor and versatility in the kitchen.

## PEARS

Bartlett, Bosc, and Comice pears are at their juiciest and most flavorful during the fall. Their delicate sweetness and buttery texture lend themselves beautifully to desserts, cheese pairings, and poached pear dishes, providing a versatile ingredient for autumn menus.

## PERSIMMONS

Fuyu, Hachiya, and Chocolate persimmons are at their best from October through December. Fuyus can be eaten raw, adding a sweet, crisp element to salads. Hachiyas, when fully ripe, are perfect for baking into cakes, breads, and puddings. Chocolate persimmons offer a unique sweet flavor and custard-like texture for both fresh eating and desserts.

## POMEGRANATES

Pomegranates, peaking from September through November, offer vibrant, jewel-like seeds that add a burst of tart flavor and a visual pop to dishes. Use them to garnish salads, enhance sauces, or create a refreshing beverages and desserts.

## ROOT VEGETABLES

Fall is prime time for an array of root vegetables in Northern California. Carrots, turnips, and beets reach their peak during this season, developing sweeter flavors as temperatures cool. These versatile vegetables shine in roasts, purees, and hearty stews. Their earthy flavors and vibrant colors (especially in varieties like rainbow carrots or golden beets) add depth and visual appeal to autumn menus.

## SQUASH

Various types of squash, including butternut and pumpkins, are at their peak during the fall months. Their rich, sweet flesh is perfect for soups, purees, and roasted vegetable medleys, adding depth and warmth to autumn dishes.
