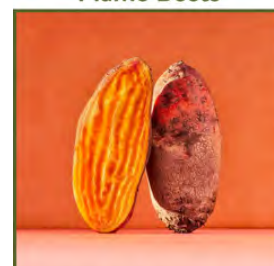

Produce News

Avocados – California growers are expecting another 2 weeks of good quality avocados. Mexico continues to have good supply but expect prices to move up as the California season winds down. Remember Mexico-grown avocados ripens up much faster, and turn brown faster, than the California fruit. Brokaw season is ending and expected to deliver the last GWEN avocado on Nov 5th and will start back up sometime in Feb with the Hass variety.

Beans – Dwelley farm is done with Romano, Cranberry and Wax beans. Trimmed French Beans remain limited due to inconsistent quality from Mexico. Mexico English Peas usually start in November.

Berries:

- Blackberries – Watsonville volume is quickly starting to slow down they are in their late season picks. Recent rain In Mexico has caused quality issues.
- Blueberries – Overall supply and quality condition report is good coming from Mexico growing regions. Peru will have steady supply this week and will continue to have good quality fruit.
- Raspberries – Watsonville season is expected to end in the next 2 weeks; quality is hit and miss. Mexico production continues to improve and quality is strong.
- Strawberries – As Watsonville/Salinas approaches the tail end of their season, only few growers will continue to harvest in this area's quality has been hit and miss. Weather in Santa Maria remains cool and damp berry quality continues to show mix result due to recent rain packing crews are doing their best to maintain clean pack. Baja MX should start in 2 weeks.

Broccoli: Broccoli Crowns are back in stock with improved quality. Organic Broccoli Crowns are still gapping due to quality at the field level. Sweet Baby Broccoli supplies have improved slightly but quality issues remain. Romanesco is gapping again due to insects. Broccoli Rabe/Rapini has seen quality issues and supply is hit or miss, currently unavailable to start the week. Organic Broccoli De Cicco is available from Coke Farm, although limited at times.

Cauliflower: Cauliflower is still having quality and insect issues and remains limited and expensive. Sweet Baby Cauliflower has seen some improvement. Organic Cauliflower is gapping due to quality. Green, Orange and Purple Cauliflower are gapping again due to insect pressure.

Lettuces: Liner Lettuces have seen some improvement in supply as Huron and Oxnard growing areas have started up but not quite in full production. Salinas has end of season quality. Prices remain high. Romaine Hearts are extremely short and expensive and will remain so until we move to Yuma. Green Leaf, Red Leaf Iceberg and Liner Romaine have seen some improvement in availability as the Huron and Oxnard growing areas have gotten started. Tanamura & Antle's Artisan Mix supplies are now coming from the Huron district in central California. Sweet Gem will be available from Huron in about a week. Babe Farms Little Gem lettuce is in stock with steady supplies. Brisa Ranches mixed Salanova Lettuces supply is steady. Comanche Creeks Organic BMX is in stock this week. Full Belly's Organic Little Gem Lettuce is in stock with steady supplies. County Lines BMX, Super Baby BMX & Speckled Romaine are in stock.

Tomatoes – Prices have moved up; supply has been tight on Roma and 5x5 tomatoes; Northern Baja growing area has slowed down and the Southern Baja growing has started up but with limited volume due to recent rain in the growing area. Mexico-grown Grape and Cherry tomato supply is steady with good quality; also prices will remain steady. Mexico-grown Toybox Cherry tomatoes supply is limited, and quality has been hit and miss the past weeks. Cherry Tomato on the Vine supply continues to be limited and quality is hit and miss from MX/CA. Mix Heirloom tomatoes supply is limited from MX and CA quality is hit and miss.
