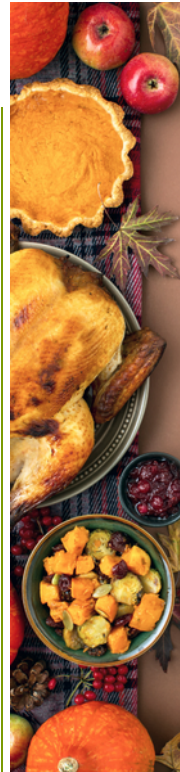

Produce News

Asparagus: The Thanksgiving week supply from Mexico will be limited and expensive. Peru availability has improved but quality is hit and miss. Peruvian White asparagus is available by 2-day Pre order. Mexico Purple asparagus is also available by 2 day pre order but quality is inconsistent.

Avocados: California season is done. Our supply is now coming from Mexico with good volume and prices on all sizes. Please note: Mexico-grown avocados ripen and turn brown faster than California grown fruit. Shelf life is short.

Beans: Trimmed French Beans remain limited due to inconsistent quality from Mexico & Guatemala. Blue Lake Bean supply is limited and expensive due quality issues coming from Mexico.

Broccoli: Broccoli Crowns are in stock. Quality has been only fair due to rains, which is also impact Value Added supplies. Sweet Baby Broccoli supplies have improved but product is still limited with higher pricing industry wide. Romanesco is gapping due to quality issues. Quality has improved on Broccoli Rabe/Rapini. Broccoli DiCicco is in great supply.

Cauliflower: Cauliflower has improved with the colder weather coming out of Salinas and Yuma. Both areas will be going until early/mid December. Sweet Baby Cauliflower is seeing better supplies with the colder weather. Organic Cauliflower is gapping due to quality. Green, Orange and Purple Cauliflower are back in stock after gapping due to insect pressure.

Celery: Celery has quality issues such as blight, black heart and pith. With the rains the fields the celery is muddy and harvesting is limited. Heavy demand for the holidays is also affecting supply. Organic is gapping due to blight issues.

Grapes: Most of the grape growers have wrapped up harvest for Green Grapes; expect supply to be very limited. Red Grapes supply will continue to be very short, and rain will not help; expect prices to be very expensive.

Greens: Spring Mix, Baby Spinach, Wild Arugula and Baby Lacinato Kale are coming in from Yuma. Supplies have been inconsistent at the field level since we had those storms last.

Melons: Arizona grown Cantaloupe supplies are limited, and prices are up to start the week. Guatemalan grown Cantaloupes will start in early December. Mexico grown Honey Dew and Seedless Watermelon supplies and prices are steady.

Onions: Green Onion supplies are still tight and seeing some minor quality issues from weather in Mexico. Peeled Shallots, Pearl and Cipollini Onions in stock through Christopher Ranch. Peeled Shallots are old crop and have lost some weight causing some bulbs to fall apart. Leeks are in good supply; Organic Leeks are in stock from Coke Farm and Lakeside.

Sprouts: Brussels Sprouts have tightened up as shippers are seeing quality and bug issues limiting supplies. Market is steady but inflated.

Strawberries: Santa Maria growers reported that recent rain caused significant damage to the fields; recovery is uncertain that some growers maybe finished for the season. Salinas/Watsonville season is officially done. Mexico fruit transfers to Texas, which leaves little availability going to CA.
