MARKET REPORT

SUPPLY & QUALITY UPDATES

BROCCOLI & CAULIFLOWER

These continue to be in bad shape with very limited supplies and very high pricing. Product that is available is having quality issues leading to lessened supply of raw product and Value-Added items. Organic Broccoli and Cauliflower are gapping.

ROUND, ROMA & CHERRY TOMATOES

Not much change in the tomato category with round tomatoes being the most impacted with no immediate relief expected. Romas have firmed up as people move to that variety in lieu of rounds. Seeing some early production from Florida and Baja, but no volume that will make an impact.

GRAPES

Peru and Chile both had lighter volume this year as the seasons wind up. Quality is mixed on remaining product as Chile winds up fast. Mexico is looking to start a little early and should see increased supplies mid-late May.

STRAWBERRIES

Weather and transitional challenges continue to affect availability. Oxnard fruit is past it's peak and Santa Maria is still ramping up. Salinas and Watsonville started early, but rain and cool temps really slowed down production.

ICEBERG LETTUCE

Fields are drying out but as usual after rain events, we are seeing more dirt presence, mildew, short shelf life and lighter weights in addition to Fusarium pressure. VA processors are fully running in Salinas which is also cutting into supply.
