MARKET REPORT

SUPPLY & QUALITY UPDATES

BROCCOLI

Broccoli supplies remain tight and many shippers are filling contracts and regular business only. Salinas Valley remains the most impacted from previous planting gaps. We are filling in with Santa Maria grown product as needed. Value Added Florets remain snug industry wide and are on 10 week averages.

STRAWBERRIES

Mother's Day demand has started to settle and weather is starting to become favorable in Salinas and Watsonville. Peak production and improved consistency is expected first week of June.

ROUND & ROMA TOMATOES

Tomato category continues to improve with Culiacan and Sonora producing rounds and romas and Baja steadily increases. We are starting to see prices drop and will continue to ease until we get to seasonable levels.

ASPARAGUS

It has been a rough go on California Asparagus this season because of unseasonable rains. Peacock, Delta and Durst are all starting to wind down as is Washington grown product. Good news is Baja quality and production is improving to come in to play when CA and WA end.

ROMAINE HEARTS

Romaine Hearts have become very limited and expensive from planting gaps caused by unseasonable rains. They are expected to be limited and on allocations until June.
