MARKET REPORT

SUPPLY & QUALITY UPDATES

BROCCOLI

Broccoli continues to be in very short supply as the Salinas Valley is dealing with planting gaps. Product is available in the Santa Maria growing area, but pricing is expensive as there is not much product around. Value-Added Florets are limited and being held to averages. Organic Broccoli is gapping.

STRAWBERRIES

Supplies have improved slightly and quality is acceptable despite the recent rains. Oxnard and Santa Maria are still dealing with some quality issues and losing product after repacking them. Expect supplies to tighten up with increased demand for Mother's Day.

ROUND, ROMA & CHERRY TOMATOES

There is relief in sight as Central Baja is starting to produce significant volume and Florida production has improved. We should see pricing return to normal mid-May.

CV ASPARAGUS

California Delta and Peacock asparagus supplies were limited this week from the rains a couple of weeks ago. Harvests are limited on large and very little availability on Jumbo. Washington supply has peaked and will be slowing down in the next 3-4 weeks; Mexican supply is limited on all sizes. Pricing is expensive across the board.

ORG ASPARAGUS

Durst Organic Asparagus supplies are expected to improve this week with the warmer weather. Purple will remain limited through the end of the season.
