SUPPLY & QUALITY UPDATES

STONEFRUIT

Stonefruit season is starting to wind down as we head into fall. Cherries are basically done for the season with Peaches, Nectarines and Plums/Pluots to follow. We will still see some Gold Bud Peaches out of Placerville that stick around maybe until October because of the higher elevations.

PINEAPPLE

The Mexican fruit is winding down and Costa Rican fruit is slowing as well as we enter the rainy months. Product will be available, but it will be tight. This is expected to last into November.

CRIMINI MUSHROOMS

Mushrooms are growing slow and there is limited product all around. All growers and suppliers are limited and producing product. We expect to see some relief in the next week or two.

STRAWBERRIES

Strawberry quality remains fair at best with shelf life minimal. High heat and warm night temps have immensely affected quality from in the Monterey and Santa Maria growing areas. Berries have thin skin, very soft texture and decay quickly.
